

Welcome Back

Welcome back to school to all our pupils, as well as a special welcome to all our new pupils who started with us this week! We hope you all had a wonderful summer and enjoyed the time with your families. Please note that school for our KS1 and KS2 children starts at 8.40am; this is the time children should be lined up in their classes ready to come into school. The school gates on Westminster Road close at 8.50am and access will only be available via Stamford Road after this time. The school day finishes at 3.10pm. Any children who have not been collected by 3.20pm are brought to the main school office and seated in the ICT suite with a member of staff. Please ensure you arrive on time to collect your children; if you are running late then please telephone the school office to notify us of any delays.

Dinner Money / Milk Money

Dinner money should be handed in to the school office on a Monday morning in a sealed envelope with your child' name and class written clearly on the front. One week's dinner money is £11.50; please ensure the correct money is handed in.
