

Places at Grammar Schools in Birmingham—YEAR 5

If your child is currently in Year 5 and you would like for them to go to grammar school in Birmingham, they will need to sit an entry test. There is one entry test across all Birmingham's grammar schools: Bishop Vesey's Grammar School for Boys, Sutton Coldfield Grammar School for Girls and all the King Edward VI Schools (Aston, Camp Hill School for Boys, Camp Hill School for Girls, Five Ways, Handsworth Grammar School for Boys and Handsworth School). More information is available on the Grammar Schools in Birmingham website. Registration for the entry test opened on 1st May 2019 and will close on Friday 28th June 2019 at 4pm. The test date is Saturday 7th September 2019. Please remember when registering you will need to upload a clear photograph of your child's face (head and shoulders) taken within the last month. If you wish to apply for a grammar school outside Birmingham, please contact the relevant local authority for that area.

Year 6 SATs Breakfast Club


