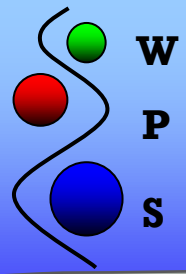

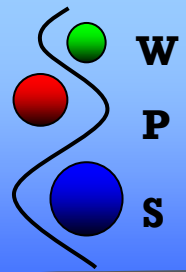
Harvest Collection
