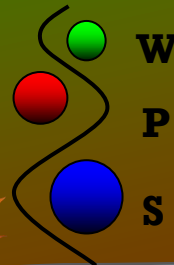

Reception Class—Admission arrangements 2019

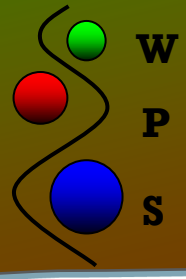
The closing date for applications is 15 January 2019.
