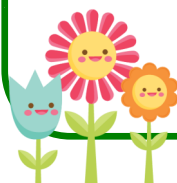
Year 1 Trip to Kinver Edge

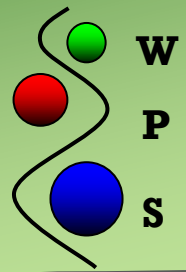


Eid
