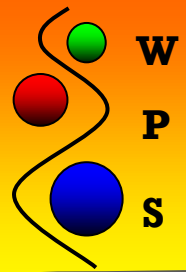
London Trip

Parents Classes and Information

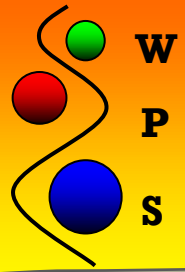
Enrolment for a Mental Health Level 2 course will take place on Mon 15th July at 9.15am in the community room.
