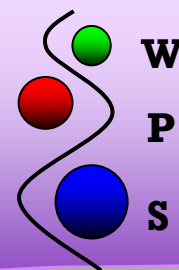

Please can we also remind all parents / carers to ensure any medical condition changes regarding your child are communicated to the school as soon as possible.

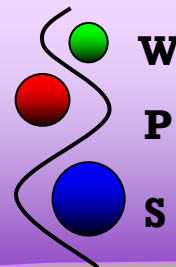
Secondary School Applications
