Outdoor PE

As part of the PE curriculum, some PE lessons will be taught outside in the playground by the teachers. Therefore we recommend you send your child in with an outer layer such as a tracksuit top or sweatshirt. This is in addition to their PE kit. In instances of extremely poor weather conditions such as heavy rain and snow, PE lessons will take place indoors.

Parking outside school

We are once again appealing for care and caution from parents and carers who are using cars for dropping and collecting their children outside school. Vehicles are still continuing to park on the zig-zag lines as well as pulling onto the pavement to park in order to drop passengers off. This is extremely dangerous as families are making their way to school in the morning and cars pulling onto the pavement could cause an accident. Cars are also stopping in the middle of the road to drop off pupils causing congestion. The Highways Agency have indicated if these problems persist then offending drivers will be fined. In the next few weeks we will be putting out signage and notices to reinforce the no-parking law on zig-zag lines. We are urging all drivers to **CONSIDER THE SAFETY OF OUR CHILDREN.**

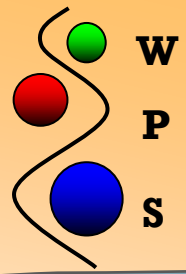
Secondary School Applications
