World Book Day

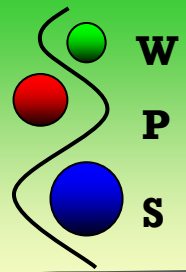

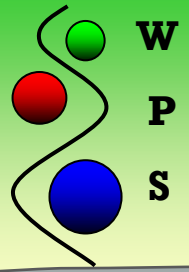


Parents Information
