### **WELCOME**

Welcome back to school to all our pupils, as well as a special welcome to all our new pupils who started with us this week! As you will be aware, many of the Covid-19 restrictions have been relaxed and classes and children are no longer required to stay in 'bubbles'. Dinner times and playtimes have also returned to their normal timings with lunch for KS1 children back to its normal time of 12.00-1.00pm and lunch for KS2 children at 12.30-1.30pm.

Please continue to follow Public Health England guidance for anyone in your household who has coronavirus symptoms. Anyone with symptoms should isolate and book a PCR test. Please inform us immediately if your child has symptoms and inform us of any test result. Close contacts who have had two doses of vaccine or are under 18 years of age, do not need to isolate.

There are no more staggered school timings for our KS1 and KS2 children in the morning. The first bell will ring at 8.35am; this is the time children should be lined up in their classes ready to come into school. The school gates on Westminster Road will close at 8.50am and access will only be available via Stamford Road after this time. The school day finishes at 3.30pm Monday to Thursday and at 12.30pm on a Friday. Please ensure you arrive on time to collect your children; if you are running late then please telephone the school office to notify us of any delays.

### Before and After School Clubs

Our before and after school sports clubs will be starting from Monday 20th September 2021. Please make sure you only send your child to the club if you have received a club acceptance letter today. Your child needs to come in their PE kit if they are attending a club in the morning; they need to bring their uniform in a bag that they can change into after their club finishes at 8.35am. Children attending an after school sports club need to bring in their PE kits in a bag and will be given time to change into their sports kit at 3.30pm. All children attending a club need to ensure they bring in a water bottle in order that they can keep hydrated. Our Play Co-ordinators will be in charge of running the clubs: Mr Khan will be running the morning clubs and Mr Azhar will be running the after school clubs.
