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MONITORING CHILDREN'S ONLINE ACTIVITY (INCLUDING WATCHING CONTENT ON YOU-TUBE & NETFLIX)

We have noticed that a number of our infant and junior children have been commenting on and discussing some of the content of a recent Netflix series. The series is rated 15; however it would appear that some of the pupils in school appear to have viewed the programme. We would urge all parents and carers to monitor their children's viewing habits and ensure that they are not watching inappropriate content. The series has a '15 rating' due to the fact that there is extremely violent subject matter in the series that is unsuitable for young people. We would advise all parents and carers to also monitor their children's online activity to ensure they are not accessing sites that are unsuitable for their age—parental controls on online devices are one way of ensuring your child only has access to materials appropriate for their age. If you would like help with setting up parental controls on your devices, please come to the school office and we will get our ICT manager to support you with this.

AFTER SCHOOL COLLECTION CLUB—'SCHOOLS OUT'

We have had a few enquiries about regular after school provision for children whose parents who are working and thus struggle with the collection of their child at 3.30pm. A number of our pupils are collected by a representative from an after school club called 'Schools Out'. The club is based in St.Clare's Catholic Primary School which is accessible via Charles Road.
