# **Updated Covid Guidelines**

The recent Covid guidelines changes are as follows:

Close contacts who are double vaccinated adults or who are under 18 years and 6 months in age do not have to isolate, but are required to carry out a daily lateral flow test for 7 days (and report the results to NHS Test and Trace).

This procedure also now applies to the **Omicron** variant i.e. if a double vaccinated adult or young person under the age of 18 years and 6 months is a close contact of someone who tested positive for Omicron, the close contact is not required to isolate, but is required to carry out a daily lateral flow test for 7 days (and report the results to NHS Test and Trace).

Close contacts of a Covid positive person, especially, those that live in the same household, should maintain distance from other people.

Considering the above, if children at our school were identified as a close contact of a positive case, they too would be asked to carry out a lateral flow test for 7 days. (This does not apply to children under 5 years of age.)

If someone tests positive after taking a lateral flow test and the PCR test is then negative, they can stop isolating, but are required to take a lateral flow test for the remainder of the 7 days, since they tested positive in the lateral flow test.


