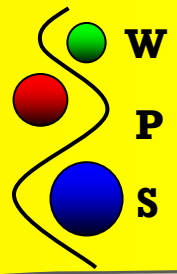
We will be sending permission letters to parents of children in Year 5 and Year 6. Please can you complete these and return to school by the end of next week.

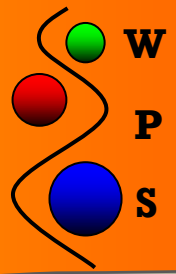
Lost Property
