Places at Grammar Schools in Birmingham—YEAR 5

If your child is currently in Year 5 and you would like for them to go to grammar school in Birmingham, they will need to sit an entry test. There is one entry test across all Birmingham's grammar schools: Bishop Vesey's Grammar School for Boys, Sutton Coldfield Grammar School for Girls and all the King Edward VI Schools (Aston, Camp Hill School for Boys, Camp Hill School for Girls, Five Ways, Handsworth Grammar School for Boys and Handsworth School). More information is available on the Grammar Schools in Birmingham website. Registration for the entry test has already opened and will close on Thursday 30th June 2022 at 4pm. The test date is Saturday 17th September 2022. To register your child for the grammar schools in Birmingham entrance test, please use the link below:

Water bottles / sun cream

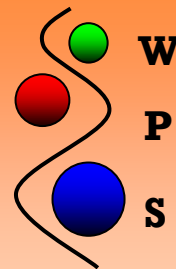
