

There is one entry test across all of the West Midlands grammar schools: Bishop Vesey's Grammar School for Boys, Sutton Coldfield Grammar School for Girls and all the King Edward VI Schools (Aston, Camp Hill School for Boys, Camp Hill School for Girls, Five Ways, Handsworth Grammar School for Boys and Handsworth School) Queen Mary's Grammar school and many more. 




