Please note that children will be unable to attend the fayre unless they are collected by an adult.

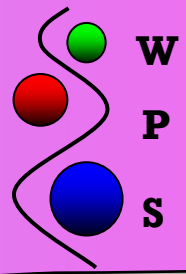
## Lost Property
